



Master of Arts in Community Counseling Course Sequences and Admission Cycles Fall 2008 and Forward

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These course sequences are designed for students who are admitted to enter the first term of the fall, spring, and summer semester and who plan to graduate in two years.

If a student enters the program in the middle of the semester, he/she will need to meet with an advisor to map out courses in a different sequence.

For students who plan to complete the program in three years, he/she may take all the core courses during the first two years, and leave the practicum and internship seminars for the third year during field training.

Courses with “**” are practicum pre-requisites.

Practicum pre-requisites are generally taken in the first year of study and considered a foundation for the other courses of the program. Students may not start their field training experience if they receive a grade below “B-” in any of these courses by the end of Summer II term prior to the beginning of the field training. Students who receive a grade lower than “B-” must retake the course within the next twelve months and receive a grade of “B-” or better
