



## ASPP SCHOLAR FELLOWSHIP American School of Professional Psychology 2010-2011

Argosy University, Chicago, American School of Professional Psychology (ASPP) is pleased to announce the ASPP Scholar Fellowship for students in the clinical psychology programs. Each academic year, the American School of Professional Psychology will award two \$5500 tuition scholarships to students who will have completed a minimum of eight courses (credit/non-credit) at Argosy University, Chicago by the end of the Spring 2010 semester.

Winners will be selected on the basis of academic excellence, clinical performance, and an essay responding to the question below. In the event of a tie, financial need will also be considered. **Previous winners are not eligible.**

In addition to being fulltime students, Fellowship recipients will serve as Research Assistants for selected faculty member for 275 hours during the academic year. The recipient will receive a tuition credit of one-half of the total award for each semester that he/she is a fulltime student, maintains satisfactory academic progress, and completes all work requirements. Students will be notified which faculty members will be available as research mentors for collaboration on a research project at the time of their award.

### **Deadline:**

**April 23, 2010 (no later than 5:00p.m.)**

**Please Note: Incomplete or late application packets will not be considered.**

### **Requirements:**

1. Students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.70 (on the 4.0 scale) and apply by the deadline.
2. A faculty committee reviews the student's entire file (academic and training).
3. Candidates must submit a statement, no longer than 500 words, 2 pages double-spaced, in response to one of the following:
  - a. Design a research project that would be feasible for a CRP with the following stipulations:
    - (1) You must spend no more than one year in implementing the experimental or intervention procedure for your CRP;

- (2) Your CRP must have the potential for making an original contribution to the field of clinical psychology.
- b. Design a clinical intervention project with the following stipulations:
    - (1) You must spend no more than one year in implementing the intervention.
    - (2) The program must represent an original contribution to the field of clinical psychology.
  - c. Write an abstract for a theoretical paper that proposes an extension of contemporary clinical theory.

We expect the statement to be organized, well written, well reasoned, and grounded in existing literature. We are looking for evidence of creative and integrative thought.

4. Identify yourself by social security number only. ***DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME ON THE ESSAY.***
5. Consideration of financial need will be used to break a tie. (We will contact you if additional information is needed.)
